CAT POLICY

We welcome animals here at Hurstwood Farm and those of the well behaved variety are welcome subject to prior agreement. We ask that clients are aware that we have many different animals here on the farm including rescue chickens, rescue dogs and cats, free range peacocks, horses and a herd of deer. Many of our animals have had a tough start in life and we work hard to create a calm and relaxed environment for them.

As well as this we pride ourselves in the immaculate condition of our cottages. It takes much time and expense to keep them this way. We do not accept animals under the age of 1 year old to stay in the cottages. All animals must be fully housetrained.

Before you let the cat out, please talk to any of the staff to ensure that our dogs are locked away

Cat mess must be cleared as and when it happens

A cat litter tray must be in existence within the cottage

Cats must be clean before entry to the cottage

Cats must not cause damage to any furniture e.g. beds and sofas

Cats must not be permitted to cause any kind of nuisance to neighbouring properties and other cottage guests. In no way must your cat impinge on other visitors enjoyment of their holiday

Cats are not to be left alone in the cottages unless permission has been previously allowed by Hurstwood Farm under specific circumstances

Any damage caused but the cat will be charged for

All cats must be vaccinated and on a regular flea and worming programme

We are sorry if these conditions seem a little strict and we know that most cat owners would comply with the above rules as a matter of course.
